The purpose of the Transparent Review of Unjust Transfers and Holds ("TRUTH") Act Community Forum is to provide information regarding Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) access to individuals and to receive and consider public comment, pursuant to Government Code Sections 7283 and 7283.1.
