To whom it may concern,

I am a resident in your district writing to you in regards to the proposed improvements to the Arcade Creek bridge. I'm glad that the proposed construction will improve our neighborhood. I'm curious as to whether other improvements near the bridge will be made, specifically extending the concrete wall at the end of Park Road.

I ask that because on August 19th 2020 we had a frightening incident at my home at 3590 Park Road in which my garage was shot at during the night.

My home is the last home located at the end of Park Road, across Arcade Park and neighbors the I-80 East Watt Avenue on ramp. At around 10 p.m. that Wednesday night an unknown individual shot multiple times from the onramp at my home damaging my garage and vehicle parked inside. This was also reported to the Sheriff's Department by my neighbor who also heard these shots. Please also see the photos of the damage that I have attached.

Though my home sustained damage, I know my immediate neighbors are also concerned about their safety and of the neighborhood and sympathize with my situation. They would also like a more solid barrier between our street and the Watt Ave on ramp. This is a rural neighborhood and many of us spend a lot of time outside, including our children, grandchildren, pets and livestock.

This is an unfortunate incident and I would like to share that it was entirely preventable, and request your assistance in finding a solution to keep our homes, street and neighbors safe. Currently, my property and the onramp are only separated by a porous chain link fence that provides insufficient coverage and protection from not only bullets, but debris and any roadway hazards.

We were lucky to avoid a tragedy this time and only sustained minimal damage to my home but now I am requesting your immediate attention to help provide a solution to keep us safe.

I specifically am asking for your assistance to look into the feasibility of solidifying the barrier beyond the chain link fence between the end of the street and the freeway on ramp.
