**APPROVE THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT
PROGRAM RECORDS REPOSITORY RETENTION/DESTRUCTION
POLICY**

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 26202 provides authority for the Board of Supervisors to authorize the destruction or disposition of any record, paper, or document which is more than two years old, which is not expressly required by law to be filed and preserved, and which the Board of Supervisors determines is no longer necessary or required to be retained for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Management Department (EMD) has developed a retention policy to ensure the proper retention of documents and records;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the EMD Program Records Repository Retention/Destruction Policy, and pursuant to California Government Code section 26202, the Director of EMD be and is hereby authorized to create and update record retention schedules as needed and to destroy or otherwise dispose of all documents in accordance with the EMD Program Records Repository Retention/Destruction Policy.
